**The date is set!!** The Lord provided and we were able to purchase our plane tickets. **On August 23, 2010 our family will be leaving for Kenya.** What an exciting time it is as we eagerly anticipate moving to our new home. After almost one year of traveling we are glad to finally be able to settle in one spot and call it home.

As is often the case in any ministry, God does not give us all the answers right away. This forces us to stay in prayer and to continually trust Him and rely on His guidance. Our initial plan was to live at the language school in Nairobi while we take Swahili language classes. This plan changed, however, when we found out that it is very expensive to live there (about \$180 per day). Prices in Nairobi have increased over the past few years so an alternative needs to be found. At this time we have contacts helping us in our search for housing in the Nairobi area. Lord willing, we will be able to live close to the language school.

In April we were able to participate in three missionary conferences. Two of the conferences were in Pennsylvania, specifically in Altoona and Duncansville. Next, we headed to Eastport, NY for our third and final missionary conference. While there,

Eastport Bible Church took us on a tour of New York City and also treated our family to a New York Mets baseball game at Citi Field. Following this, we visited grace churches in New Jersey, Virginia, West Virginia, and Ohio on the weekends. What a joy it was to present our vision for the country of Kenya in all these churches! It's hard to believe, but no more missionary conferences for our family. We continue to visit churches, but our "tour" with other missionaries has come to an end.

As of receiving this letter our family will be in Florida visiting three grace churches. We will begin by visiting Fellowship Bible Church in Orlando, then on to Grace Bible Church in Palm Bay, and finally Grace Bible Church in Nokomis. After this we head back to Indiana and prepare for one week at the Berean Bible Fellowship Conference in Cedar Lake, IN. I (Jim) will be speaking at this conference on Monday June 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 AM. Our family hopes to see many of you at the conference **AND** at the bright & early 7 AM meeting.

Training is vital to any missionary and entering a new culture demands knowing what to expect and how to handle it. Now not every situation can be prepared for, but training is important in helping one adapt to a new environment. Missy and I have the opportunity to participate in a missions training program through Shepherd Staff Ministries. This training program is a 2 week intensive program (July 10-24) on adapting to a new culture and practical ministry work among the people of a different land (in this case, the people of Tijuana, Mexico).

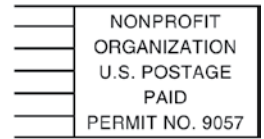
