Mario did the devotion at the first house and then we had lunch (Indonesians are very hospitable – food of some sort served at every house you visit); then it was on to the second house meeting where I got to do the devotion. While the ladies stayed at that meeting, the men went on to a third meeting to preach. Overall, a very interesting experience, and I thank everyone for their prayers and interest while I was on this trip.”
