Sunday after Sunday they send video lessons to four churches for their Sunday online services. Vincent preaches and teaches online services and was able to counsel OFW's (Overseas Filipino Workers), families, pastors and leaders. We praise the Lord that people see the need to be faithful even though times are tough. Praise the Lord!

THE PROGRESS OF THE WORK

There are so many things we have experienced this year so far. We have had good and tough times, but all in all, God is faithful and has good thoughts toward us. He loves us more than we think.
