Dear Partners in God's Mission,

Greetings to you in the grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! 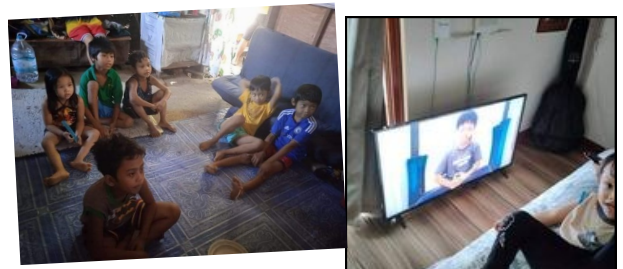

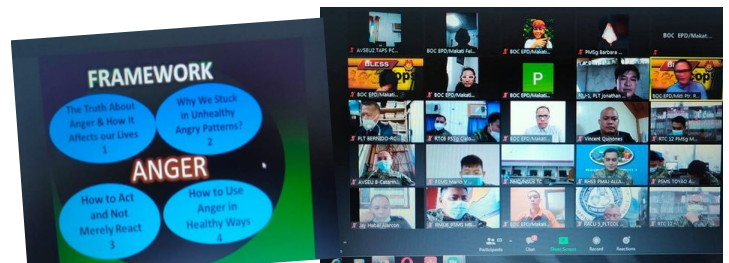

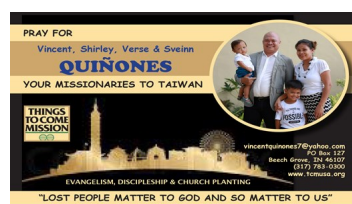
