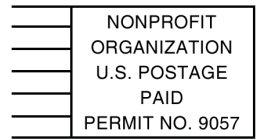
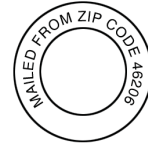

Missionary training in Philippines – June 2022

We are thankful that in May, the government of Thailand renewed our missionary visa for another year. We are thankful also for financial provision as renewing a missionary visa in Thailand is not cheap. We continue to provide spiritual leadership and faithfully proclaim God's word to our Thai brothers and sisters at our Church. We have just finished our study in the book of Philippians. Now, our series of lessons is *Secure in the Love of God* for several Sundays. We are thankful to see spiritual growth among our members. One member named Teacher Bee is always sharing the gospel with her fellow Thais. Teacher Bee is a biology teacher at a prestigious high school in Chiangmai. Several times, she encouraged Verna and me to just keep sowing the gospel even if we might not see a harvest. The stronghold of Buddhism in the country of Thailand is almost unbreakable as Evangelical Christianity has been around for more than 200 years now, but born-again Christians are still less than one percent. Indeed, we thank the Lord unceasingly for Teacher Bee and several others. Teacher Bee is the only born-again Christian in her family and clan. Please pray for Teacher Bee, Jin, Phonrawin, Nuttee, Wan, Nong Da, Nong Chang, Tammee, and Joe as they face extreme pressure from their Buddhist family and relatives. We had a few others who went back to Buddhism.

In June, Verna and I went to the Philippines as I was invited to teach at the GTCM missionary training organized by Things to Come Mission. Missionary training applicants were selected by the TCM leadership. After the training, they will be sent to different countries. In the past, we had a trainee from Indonesia and this year, we had trainees from Cambodia. All applicants have exhibited God's missionary calling in their lives prior to acceptance in the training. We had to observe lots of travel protocols in Thailand and the Philippines as we haven't been out of the country of Thailand for almost three years due to the worldwide pandemic.

Aside from my teaching at the missionary training, we visited our families located on the different islands. It was sad, as my (Genesis') mother could not remember me anymore. She has been suffering from dementia and is now 93 years old. We are thankful that both of my parents are still alive. We also visited Verna's elder brother. He has been unwell for several years now. Our last stop in the Philippines was in Dumaguete. Josiah needed some help as he moved to a new house near Silliman University. We are thankful that God provided a rented apartment near his university. For several days, we had to help him either move his things or buy basic furniture to furnish his apartment. Later, Josiah made a one-month visit to Thailand as for almost three years, he was unable to come home to Thailand. He is back in the Philippines now and continuing his study.

Verna and I tested Covid positive a few weeks ago. We both had almost all the symptoms except taste. So thankful that our sense of taste and smell didn't go away. We could say, that Covid is no fun as even at present we have not yet fully regained our strength. One night, we were concerned as Verna's oxygen level dropped, but God in His mercy sustained and grant healing to Verna and me.

Beloved, please pray that God will provide us with co-workers here in Thailand. Our last visit to reconnect with individuals and churches in America was in August 2017. It is hard for us to be away for several months without someone who can oversee the work in Thailand.

Beloved, thank you for standing behind us in praying and giving. Your partnership plays a vital role in the work we are doing in the country of Thailand. There are millions of unreached people who need to hear the gospel.
