Team Myanmar missionaries, **Dan & Amy Banac**, have returned to the Philippines for a long overdue furlough after 7 ½ years of service in Myanmar. Pray for them as they

reconnect with family and churches and put their daughter, Daniela, in college.

Church planting Director **Peter Kagwi** and Coast Director **Benson Mwaniki** visted to help find a suitable place and permits to hold church services. Pray for the Mombasa church as

they physically relocate their church building after losing half their property in a court case.

TIMOR: Pray for start-up Bible studies in two outlying districts. Pray for acquisition of an affordable lot in Dili for constructing a church, because the government requires a church building to legally exercise pastoral ministries and ceremonies. Pray for
